On October 7-8, 2010, Environmental Quality Management, Inc. performed an emission compliance test at the facility indicated above on Boiler No. 1 (B003). Ohio EPA received the test report on November 9, 2010. The test report has been reviewed and we have concluded that the test was conducted according to the procedures specified in 40 CFR Part 60, Appendix A, U.S. EPA Test Methods (1 - 4, and 5, 6, 7E, 8, 10, 25A, and 26). The results of the test showed the source to be out of compliance with the applicable Ohio EPA regulations and your facility permit terms and conditions.

Our test review shows the following:
