Dear Mr. Sheera:

On July 8, 2009, a representative of the Akron Regional Air Quality Management District (ARAQMD) inspected the Petrol US gasoline dispensing facility located at 8851 Wooster Pike Road in Seville to determine compliance with OAC 3745-21-09 (DDD) regarding Stage II vapor recovery.

Inspection results/Deficiencies:

Record keeping: No records were available for review. **Petro US is in violation of OAC rule 3745-21-09 (DDD)(3) which specifies the records that are to be kept and their availability.** You must obtain a certificate of Stage II training.

Equipment: This facility failed Stage II testing on 7/8/09. Repair and retesting are to be completed within 30 days.

Dispenser 7-8 was found to have the Gilbarco Stage II vapor control system intentionally disabled. The vacuum system was unplugged and the dispenser was in service. **Petro US is in violation of OAC rule 3745-21-09 (DDD)(1).**

By August 8, 2009, you are required to have repairs and retesting completed as well as establishing the required record keeping on-site, including obtaining Stage II training certification.

It is required that you keep record keeping information at a readily available location for inspection. For this Agency, it is requested that you keep copies of the required information at each individual location where all employees can access them. Enclosed is a list of companies that provide Stage II training and testing.

Acceptance of the corrections requested by this Agency does not constitute a waiver of this Agency's or the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. The determination to pursue or decline such penalties will be made at a later date.
