Akron Regional Air Quality Management District has concluded that Cargill, Incorporated - Salt Division (Akron, OH) did not complete stack testing in accordance with OAC rule 3745-110-04(B), which states by not later than two years after the effective date (12/22/07) of this rule, if combustion modifications are required to demonstrate compliance with the applicable emission limitations. This rule is applicable to emissions unit B006 at your facility.

OAC Rule 3745-110-05 (A) states any owner or operator of a source which is subject to the requirements of rule 3745-110-03 of the Administrative Code shall demonstrate compliance with the applicable emissions limit(s) by performing emission tests in accordance with USEPA Method 7, 7A, 7C, 7D, or 7E, and any additional approved USEPA methods as applicable.

In order to address these compliance deficiencies, please submit the following compliance plan and schedule for each of the aforementioned emissions units. Submit this plan to the attention of Duane LaClair at Akron RAQMD.
