**Re: Failure to Submit the Synthetic Minor Title V Fee Emission Report for Calendar Year 2007**

Dear Mr. Rakitsky:

My staff has informed me that Quality Carriers, Inc. failed to submit a Synthetic Minor Title V ("SMTV") Fee Emission Report for calendar year 2007. SMTV Fee Emission Reports were legally due April 15 for the preceding calendar year.

Your facility has been identified as a SMTV facility. SMTV facilities are required by Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Rule 3745-78-02(F) to report actual emissions annually. Failure to timely submit a Fee Emission Report is a violation of OAC Rule 3745-78-02(F) and ORC §§ 3704.05(G) and 3745.11.

Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter, Quality Carriers, Inc. is requested to submit the Fee Emission Report for calendar year 2007. Please be advised that starting from June 30, 2008, submitting Fee Emission Reports online using Air Services is the only acceptable filing method. Hard copy forms and Starship files are not acceptable anymore. Air Services is part of Ohio EPA's new eBusiness Center available at <http://ebiz.epa.ohio.gov>.

You are required to take a series of steps before you can successfully submit your Fee Emission Report online using Air Services. Please carefully follow the enclosed instructions to file using Air Services. If you need assistance, please refer to the phone numbers listed at the end of the document. Online help is available from the main page of the eBusiness Center.

If you fail to submit the Fee Emissions Report by the above deadline, Ohio EPA will consider its enforcement options including referral of the matter to the Ohio Attorney General's Office for appropriate legal action.

The submission of the Fee Emission Report for calendar year 2007 does not constitute a waiver of Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in ORC §3704.06. Ohio EPA will decide whether to pursue or decline to pursue penalties regarding this matter at a later date.


