**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mrs. Lee:

The Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Bright N Fresh Dry Cleaners on December 27, 2011. Following the inspection, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) on January 30, 2012. The NOV required Bright N Fresh Dry Cleaners to document weekly leak inspections, submit quarterly deviation reports and submit an updated permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) application for the dry cleaning machine.

CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action Plan (RCAP) on July 30, 2012. The RCAP acknowledged a transfer of ownership which occurred on March 26, 2012, and the receipt of a PTIO application dated June 26, 2012. The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) issued Bright N Fresh a PTIO, #P0110363, on July 13, 2012. The RCAP also acknowledged that the new PTIO eliminated the requirement to submit quarterly deviation reports. The RCAP requested a copy of completed leak inspections be submitted.

On August 17, 2012, CDAQ received the weekly leak inspection log for June 18 through August 13, 2012. CDAQ is returning the leak inspection log for you to keep in your records.

Although quarterly reports are not required any more, Bright N Fresh Dry Cleaners is expected to submit an annual Permit Evaluation Report (PER). The PER's purpose is for reporting any deviations from your PTIO terms and conditions. Your first PER is due February 15, 2013.

Appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
