**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Eliason:

On 4/26/12 and 5/11/12, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Oakwood Sunoco located at 22775 Broadway Ave. in Oakwood. On 5/23/12, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) letter informing you that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Oakwood Sunoco failed to obtain Stage II Compliance Specialist Certification for the current site manager. This is a violation of Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(3)(a)(vi) and Permit to Install/Operate (PTIO) # P0095709 Part (C)(1)(d)(2)(g).

On 6/6/12, CDAQ received notification from Debbie Hamer at Tank Integrity confirming that "Henry" from Oakwood Sunoco had called to schedule his Stage II training. She mentioned that it may be a while until they had a full class.

On 7/5/12, CDAQ contacted Ms. Hamer regarding the anticipated date for the next training. She advised the inspector that Tank Integrity normally conducts only one class per year and that the last session had occurred in January 2012.

On 7/6/12, CDAQ issued a second NOV acknowledging Oakwood Sunoco's attempt to obtain the required training, but clarifying the timeframe noted to achieve compliance was unacceptable. A list of companies who provide Stage II Compliance Specialist Training was enclosed with the letter.

CDAQ requested that Oakwood Sunoco provide Stage II Compliance Specialist Training for the operator or current site manager and submit a copy of the certificate of completion to by 7/27/12.



CDAQ is in receipt of a copy of the Stage II Compliance Specialist Training Certificate provided electronically on 9/10/12.

The corrective action plan was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action. 


