SECOND NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failing Stage II tests**

Dear Mr. Zayed:

On October 20, 2011, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected S & T Food & Oil, Inc. (S & T Shell) located at 13441 Euclid Avenue in East Cleveland. This letter serves as notification that you are operating sources in violation of the following applicable air statutes or air regulations.

On October 25, 2011 CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation because pump #1 failed the air-to-liquid ratio tests. The letter notified S & T Shell about equipment defects which must be corrected. The failure to successfully pass the testing requirements specified in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(2), while causing, allowing or permitting the transfer of gasoline from a stationary storage tank to a motor vehicle, are a violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(1)(c) and the Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3704.05(G).

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that S & T Shell make the repairs to pump No. 1, conduct a successful A/L re-test and then submit the test results to the following enforcement representative:

CDAQ must receive the test results within 30 days of your receipt of this letter. If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response that includes a timeline for correcting the alleged violations must be received within 30 days.



Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in ORC Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than \$25,000 or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

Free assistance with state and/or federal regulations, rules, laws or permit conditions can be provided at no charge through Ohio EPA Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP). OCAPP can be contacted at <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/ocapp> or 614/644-3469 or 800/329-7518. CDAQ makes no guarantee that the facility will meet the qualifying guidelines established by the OCAPP.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
