**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Karaja:

On 3/14/12, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Exxbo, Inc. located at 11622 Bellaire Rd. in Cleveland.

On 4/13/12, the CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) requiring Exxbo, Inc. to provide gasoline and used oil annual throughput records and to obtain City Permits to Operate for 2010 and 2011. On 6/28/12, CDAQ received payment for the City Permits to Operate for 2010 and 2011.

On 7/19/12, CDAQ issued a second NOV requiring Exxbo, Inc. to provide gasoline and used oil annual throughput totals (gallons) for the period 1/1/11 to 12/31/11 for the purpose of determining volatile organic compound (VOC) emissions compliance. Additionally, you were informed that 2012 City Permit Fees were now due.

On 9/26/12, CDAQ met with you on site and reviewed the records for gasoline and used oil annual throughput totals (gallons) for the period 1/1/11 to 12/31/11. Compliance with the allowable limit of 1.86 tons of VOC emissions per year was established. Additionally, you provided payment for the 2012 City Permit Fee at that time.

The required information was provided and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
