NOTICE OF VIOLATION
RESOLUTION OF VIOLATION / NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP
LETTER: Failing Annual Stage II Testing**

Dear Mrs. Wargo:

On October 26, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected S & J Automotive Services DBA Bedford Sunoco (Bedford Sunoco) located at 667 Northfield Road in Bedford. This letter serves as notification that you operated a source in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

On October 15, 2012, Bedford Sunoco failed an Air-to-Liquid Test on Emissions Unit G001: Dresser/Wayne, pump #2. The failure to successfully pass the testing requirements specified in Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(2), while causing, allowing, or permitting the transfer of gasoline from a stationary storage tank into a motor vehicle, was a violation of OAC Rule 3745-21-09(DDD)(1)(c) and Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Chapter 3704.05(G).

An Air-to-Liquid Ratio retest on pump #2 was performed and passed on October 17, 2012.

The corrective action was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
