Dear Mr. Votaw:

This letter shall serve to resolve the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to Pahl's Ready Mix Concrete in Bryan, OH on October 25, 2012. The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the company's letter dated November 1, 2012 which responded to the NOV that was generated following a complaint investigation conducted on October 18, 2012. Pahl's Ready Mix Concrete has addressed the violations identified in the NOV with the following:

- (1) The facility was not maintaining the appropriate visible emission records for emissions units F001-F003 and P001, pursuant to monitoring and recordkeeping requirements specified in C.1.d)(1) through d)(3), C.2.d)(1), C.3.d)(1) and C.4.d)(1) of permit-to-install and operate (PTIO) P0087809, issued January 20, 2012. This office requested a compliance plan explaining the recordkeeping program that was to be implemented and a timeline for doing so.

The company provided a response to the NOV which included confirmation of performing and recording daily visible emission checks and recording the amount of water applied each day to control fugitive emissions as of October 19, 2012. This response was received via email on November 1, 2012. The compliance plan outlined by Pahl's Ready Mix complies with the above specified monitoring and recordkeeping requirements.

The violations noted in the NOV letter have been addressed and are considered resolved. Please note that the submission of the requested information does not constitute waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will determine later whether to pursue such penalties in this case.
