**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mrs. Greene:

On September 6, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Karl's Sunoco located at 8404 Carnegie Avenue in Cleveland.

On September 28, 2012, CDAQ issued a Notice of Violation requiring Karl's Sunoco to:

1. Perform an Air-to-Liquid (A/L) ratio and Static Leak test, and submit the test results.
2. Submit a copy of your current Ohio EPA operating permit.
3. Submit a copy of a Stage II compliance specialist certificate.
4. Submit a copy of the Stage II testing for the last three (3) years.
5. Submit a copy of records of repair and maintenance work performed since January 1, 2012.

On October 17, 2012, Karl's Sunoco passed the annual A/L ratio and Static Leak test, and submitted the test results.

On October 25, 2012, Karl's Sunoco submitted a copy of their current Ohio EPA operating permit, a copy of previous Stage II testing results, and a copy of Stage II weekly inspection sheets which includes records of repair and maintenance work performed.

On November 15, 2012, Karl's Sunoco submitted a copy of a Stage II compliance certificate.



The appropriate steps were taken to bring your gasoline dispensing facility into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
