Dear Giulio Gabriele:

On 6/1/2010, federally enforceable permit-to-install and operate (FEPTIO) #P0102955 was issued to the above-referenced facility. Pursuant to section C.3.f(1)a. of the permit, the permittee shall conduct, or have conducted, emission testing for the following emissions units within 6 months after permit issuance:

The Akron Regional Air Quality Management District (ARAQMD) has concluded that Meggitt Aircraft Braking Systems Corporation did not complete stack testing for these emissions units by 12/1/2010 in accordance with the requirements of the permit terms and conditions. This letter or information pursuant to this letter does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Ohio Revised Code. Ohio EPA will determine later whether to pursue such penalties in this case.
