**RE: Notice of Violation for Failing to Submit Required Reports; Central Waste Inc.
DAPC FAC. ID 0250000806**

Dear Mr. Kohn:

Central Waste, Inc. is in violation the reporting requirements in the facility's permits to install issued by the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) and needs to take prompt action. By January 15, 2013, please submit:

- The second quarter 2012 compliance reports required by the facility's PTIs; and
- The third quarter 2012 compliance reports required by the facility's PTIs;

Submit the required quarterly compliance reports

The quarterly compliance reports for second quarter due July 31, 2012 and third quarter 2012 due by October 31, 2012 were not submitted to DAPC in violation of Central Waste's permits to install.

Deviation reports are required by the terms and conditions of Permits to Install (PTI) 02-18642 (issued 1/18/2005 for F002 landfill, F003 storage piles, F005 relocation of asbestos containing material, T003 200,000 tank), 02-22538 (issued 9/4/2007 for F001 roadways), 02-14069 (issued 8/8/2000 for F004 material handling at bulking pit), and 02-2762 (issued 3/10/1999 for T001, T002 tanks).

Reports required until emissions units permanently shutdown and permits withdrawn

Central Waste, Inc. is required to submit the quarterly and annual reports according to the facility's PTIs and Ohio Revised Code 3704.05(C). In addition, Central Waste, Inc. is required to submit an annual Title V Fee Emission Report by April 15 of each year according to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) 3745-78.

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
Should Central Waste choose to permanently shut down the emissions units, OAC 3745-31-02(C) provides for the relief of obligation to comply with the terms and conditions of the PTIs, including the reporting requirements. Any written notification of the permanent shutdown of any or all emissions units at the facility should either be directed to my attention at this address, or should be submitted through Air Services.

In summary, immediate action is needed for Central Waste, Inc. to return to compliance with the current DAPC permits and Ohio Air Pollution Control regulations. Be advised that violations of state air pollution regulations are punishable by a civil penalty of \$25,000 per violation. Issuance of this notice does not excuse past violation of federal, state and local laws regarding air pollution. This office reserves the right to pursue violations of air pollution regulations in the form of a referral to Ohio EPA's Central Office.

Please submit the information requested **no later than January 15, 2013**, through Air Services.
