**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Scholz:

On October 9, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation requiring Bardons and Oliver, Inc. (Bardons) to submit a corrective action plan outlining the steps that will be taken to complete the record keeping as required by PTIO #P0095912 Part C. 1.(c).(2.) and Part C. 2.(c).(2.). CDAQ received a corrective action plan dated October 26, 2012, that included hourly emission rate calculations and a sample of record keeping for emission units (EU) K001: Large Binks Spray Booth and EU K002: Small Binks Spray Booth. Bardons also provided complete record keeping via email on November 2, 2012.

On November 21, 2012, CDAQ issued a Receipt of Corrective Action letter (RCAP) stating that CDAQ did not accept the hourly emission rate calculations provided by Bardons on November 2, 2012. The hourly limit of 3 gallons per hour based on the daily allowable rate is not an accurate portrayal of the hourly rate at which the spray booths are used. CDAQ requested new calculations with accurate hourly emission rates for EUs K001 and K002 within fourteen (14) days of receipt of the RCAP.

On December 12, 2012, CDAQ received a letter from Bardons requesting an extension to complete a Permit-to-install/operate (PTIO) application to facilitate operational flexibility.

On December 13, 2012, CDAQ issued a second RCAP requiring Bardons to submit PTIO applications for EUs K001 and K002 within thirty (30) days of receipt of the second RCAP.

On January 4, 2013, Bardons submitted PTIO applications for EUs K001 and K002 to CDAQ.

The corrective action was received and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.



CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
