NOTICE OF VIOLATION: Failure to submit Annual Permit Evaluation Report for calendar year 2011; Failure to obtain City of Cleveland permit-to-operate for calendar years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2012

Dear Ms. Trotter:

This letter serves as notification that you are operating a source located at 11401 St. Clair Avenue in Cleveland in violation of the following applicable air statutes, air regulations, or air permit conditions.

Trotter's Dry Cleaners has failed to submit an Annual Permit Evaluation Report (PER) for the reporting period of October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012, for the following emission unit (EU); D001: Realstar petroleum (DF-2000) dry to dry cleaning machine equipped with a refrigerated condenser, which was due no later than November 15, 2012. This is a violation of Ohio Revised Code (ORC) Section 3704.05(C), and the following permit-to-install/operate (PTIO): #P0094978, Authorization (page 1) and Emission Unit Terms and Conditions section C.1.e.2. (page 12), issued to Trotter's Dry Cleaners on July 13, 2012.

Trotter's Dry Cleaners has also failed to obtain a City of Cleveland permit-to-operate by not submitting city permit fees for calendar years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2012. This is a violation of City of Cleveland Codified Ordinances 259.01 and 263.01.

Unless you undertake some type of corrective action with respect to the above noted violations, you will remain in non-compliance. CDAQ requests that Trotter's Dry Cleaners submit a PER for calendar year 2011 and obtain City of Cleveland permits-to-operate by submitting city permit fees for calendar years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2012, within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to the following address:

An Annual PER for the reporting period of October 1, 2011 – September 30, 2012, is included with this letter. City of Cleveland Air Pollution Source Invoices for calendar years 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2012, are also included with this letter.

If there is insufficient time to correct the alleged violations within this timeframe, a written response which includes a timeline for correcting the alleged violations must be received within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter.

Violations of Ohio air pollution laws and /or permit terms and conditions are subject to the penalties stipulated in Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.99(A), which allows fines of not more than twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) or imprisonment for not more than one year, or both, for each violation.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence. The failure to mention any specific violation does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
