(0351010073) on May 18, 2010.

Dear Mr. Bellamy:

This letter shall serve as notification of the resolution to the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the above-referenced facility on May 18, 2010. The NOV letter required the facility to submit a Permit-to-Install and Operate (PTIO) application for the hot-dip galvanizing kettle emissions unit that would resolve the public nuisance pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-15-07(A). In addition, there was a requirement to conduct emissions testing on the emissions unit.

Ohio Galvanizing Corporation (OGC) was issued a PTIO (#P0108325) on December 16, 2011, resolving the permitting deficiencies of emissions unit F003 (hot-dip galvanizing kettle and associated processes). In addition, OGC conducted emission testing on F003 on May 16, 2012. A stack test letter was sent to your attention with the results of that testing. This emissions testing satisfied the requirement set forth in the NOV letter, thereby resolving that issue.

With the issuance of the PTIO and the emissions testing of F003, the violations cited in the NOV letter have been resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC §3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
