Dear Mr. Wensink:

This letter shall serve as follow-up to the Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated December 29, 2011, regarding the above-referenced facility. In the NOV letter, Luckey Farmers, Inc. was found to be in violation of having installed and operated emissions units without acquiring proper permits pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) rule 3745-31-02.

Luckey Farmers, Inc. submitted a Permit-to-Install and Operate (PTIO) application on January 26, 2012, to initiate resolution to the noted violation in the NOV letter. The facility was issued PTIO #P0109403 on February 24, 2012, thereby returning the facility into compliance with the rules and regulations of the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC). Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC §3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
