**RESOLUTION OF VIOLATIONS  
NOTICE OF VIOLATION FOLLOW-UP LETTER**

Dear Mr. Salem:

On December 19, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) inspected Gas USA located at 3934 West 117<sup>th</sup> Street in Cleveland. Gas USA conducted Stage II testing for emissions unit (EU) G001: Gasoline dispensing facility with Stage I and Stage II controls on December 19, 2012. The Static Leak (SL) test failed at this time. Further testing was not attempted at this time.

On December 21, 2012, the Cleveland Division of Air Quality (CDAQ) issued a Notice of Violation Letter requiring Gas USA to make the necessary repairs, conduct a re-test of the Static Leak (SL) test, complete Dynamic Pressure and Air-to-Liquid Ratio (A/L) tests, and submit test results within thirty (30) days of receipt of the letter.

CDAQ is in receipt of a corrective action dated January 18, 2013 at which time test results were received demonstrating that a re-test of the SL test and completion of Dynamic Pressure and Air-to-Liquid Ratio (A/L) tests were all completed and passed on January 15, 2013.

The corrective action was received in a timely manner and appropriate steps were taken to bring the source into compliance. CDAQ has determined that no further enforcement action is warranted at this time, but reserves its right to take such action in the future if necessary.

CDAQ issues this letter with Ohio EPA's concurrence and does not excuse any violations of local, state and federal laws or regulations regarding air pollution control. Violations of air pollution control laws may be pursued in local court or referred to Ohio EPA or U.S. EPA for further enforcement action.
