Dear Mr. Tennar:

On December 13, 2012, SEMCO was issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) for emission units R001 – R006. The company failed to perform and document inspections of the dry filtration system and failed to document any time periods when the dry particulate filter was not in service while these emissions units were in operation. The Ohio EPA received a response letter from SEMCO on January 7, 2013. After discussions with our office, the company responded by email on January 16, 2013 with revised documentation.

The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) has reviewed the email which included a periodic inspection sheet and a mold count sheet. Based on the company's response we have determined that SEMCO is back in compliance. No further action is being taken at this time for the violations cited in the December 13, 2012 NOV and these violations are considered resolved.

Please note for the two violations cited above, that the submission of the requested information to respond to these violations does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make the decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter at a later date.
