Dear Mr. Keiber:

On February 24, 2009, the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) issued a Notice of Violation (NOV) to Accubuilt, Inc. for violations of the 10 gallons per day coating use limitation for the following emissions units: K002 - Funeral Coach Prime Station (Booth No. 8) and K004 - Funeral Coach Paint Station (Booth No. 13). These violations occurred during the fourth quarter of 2008.

Review of the 2012 permit evaluation report submitted by the company for Permit to Install and Operate No. P0086719, issued December 30, 2011, indicated that compliance is being maintained with the 10 gallons per day coating use limitation for these two emissions units (and all other emissions units subject to the limitation) during the year, with one exception on April 9, 2012. On that day, coating use was 10.094 gallons for emissions unit K004.

With compliance being demonstrated from April 10, 2012, through December 31, 2012, the violation for the 10 gallons per day coating use limitation has been resolved. Please note, however, that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for these violations. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this matter is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
