Dear Mr. Shade:

This letter shall serve as a follow-up to the inspection conducted on February 13, 2013, of the above referenced facility by Chad Winebrenner and Alyse Johnson of the Division of Air Pollution Control/Northwest District Office (DAPC/NWDO). The purpose of this inspection was to determine the compliance status of all air contaminant emissions units located there.

Based on discussions and observations during the inspection, along with a review of the company's files, my findings are as follows:

1. Newman Technologies, Inc. is required to conduct stack testing for compliance with the short term OC limit and the ninety-five percent destruction efficiency for the thermal incinerator. The stack test should have been completed within 12 months of permit issuance for permit P0087523, issued July, 15 2010, for coating line K001. The test was required to be performed no later than July 15, 2011. This test has not been completed, resulting in a violation of PTIO term C.1.f)(1)a.- e. and ORC 3704.05 for emissions unit K001.
2. In addition, it appears that Newman Technology, Inc. has started using several coatings in K001 that had not been listed in a prior Emissions Activity Category (EAC) form. Several coatings have also stopped being used completely. Ohio EPA is requesting an updated EAC form for K001 detailing the coatings now used in the process.

Ohio EPA requests Newman Technologies, Inc. submit a compliance plan for conducting stack testing for K001. Both the compliance plan and information requested in item #2 should be submitted to Ohio EPA – NWDO no later than March 22, 2013.

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Please be advised that submission of information to respond to this letter does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties pursuant to ORC Section 3704.06. The Ohio EPA will make a decision whether to pursue such penalties regarding this matter a later date.
