Dear Mr. Meyers:

The Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) is in receipt of Erie County Department of Environmental Services (DOES) letter dated March 2, 2013. Upon the review of the information submitted, the following has been determined:

1. A visible emissions violation of OAC rule 3745-17-07(B) was recorded on January 31, 2013, for the facility's unpaved roadways because water as a control measure could not be employed to control fugitive emissions due to freezing/unsafe weather conditions. DAPC has reevaluated the visible emissions information documented that day by the facility in light of weather conditions and the alternate control measure employed and agrees that no permit violation occurred because the facility had documented in its daily visible emissions record book that conditions were hazardous and an alternate method of control (speed control) was being utilized.

Based on the current permit terms and conditions, a deviation report would be the appropriate way for the facility to indicate that the inspection determined the need for control measures but that the facility could not implement water usage as control because of freezing/unsafe conditions. Therefore, it has been determined that no further enforcement action will be pursued regarding the visible emissions observed from the facility's unpaved roadways on the day of the inspection and the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the facility, dated February 15, 2013, is hereby resolved.


As documented in the facility's compliance plan, DAPC appreciates the efforts made (i.e., the installation of speed bumps and letters to the facility's hauling companies) to address the implementation of the posted speed limit at the facility in order to reduce fugitive dust emissions.
