Dear Mr. Kraus,

This letter serves as a Notice of Violation to Container Port Group for the failure to submit a timely permit application for renewal of the permit identified above which expired on July 18, 2012. This failure to submit a complete and timely application, has resulted in the loss of the "application shield" provided by Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 119.06, for the air contaminant sources (emissions units) identified above.

Continued operation of the emissions unit(s) noted above after the expiration date of the permit, without a valid renewal permit being issued by the Director, will be a violation of OAC rule 3745-31-02. Be advised that submission of a permit renewal application, will not reinstate the "application shield" provided by (ORC) section 119.06.

Please submit a complete renewal application to the South West Ohio Air Quality Agency as soon as possible, but no later than 15 days from receipt of this notice. A PTIO Application along with the appropriate Engineering Activity Category (EAC) form must be submitted for your permit to be renewed. These forms may be found at:

Acceptance by the Ohio EPA of a compliance plan and schedule does not constitute a waiver of the Ohio EPA's authority to seek civil penalties as provided in Section 3704.06 of the Revised Code.
