Dear Mr. Guerra:

This letter shall serve as a follow-up to the Notice of Violation (NOV) letter dated February 14, 2013, for the above-referenced facility. The purpose of this letter is to indicate the facility's return to compliance status. This was accomplished by the following:

1. Issuance of Permit to Install P0113400 issued on April 4, 2013, for thirteen emission units including: P032, P309, P312, P324, P329, P334, P307, P308, P310, P311, P326, P332, and P333.
2. On April 11, 2013, the facility provided emission calculations for the three RX Gas Generators (P046). Calculations presented for this emission unit demonstrates particulate emissions would qualify as "de minimis" under OAC Rule 3745-15-05. This emission unit will be assigned a permit exemption status of "de minimis" under the facility profile.
3. All other issues noted in DAPC's NOV letter dated February 14, 2013, have been completed and/or addressed by the facility.

At this time, the Notice of Violation (NOV) issued to the facility, dated February 14, 2013, is hereby resolved. Please note that this does not preclude the Director from seeking civil penalties pursuant to ORC section 3704.06 for the violation noted in the NOV letter. The decision on whether to pursue or decline to pursue such penalties regarding this is dependent on several factors, one of which is the company's future compliance with applicable Ohio EPA requirements.
