Dear Mr. Buckey:

On December 6, 2012, Mykal Mercer and I performed an inspection of Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat, located at 1775 Southgate Parkway, Guernsey County, Ohio. On December 26, 2012, Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat was issued a notice of violation (NOV). On January 22, 2013, Ohio EPA received a compliance plan from Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat. This letter is in response to the provided compliance plan.

Violation and Requested Action:

During the inspection, you stated that you are currently performing visual leak inspections on a weekly basis. You stated that you check all seals, fittings, doors, etc., however you do not currently have any records to support this. Permit-to-install 06-07387 requires weekly visual leak inspections to be conducted and recorded. Ohio EPA requested that Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat immediately comply with all monitoring and recordkeeping requirements in accordance with the terms and conditions of PTI 06-07387.

Response:

Enclosed with the compliance plan was a copy of the visual leak inspection records for January 2013. During our phone conversation on January 15, 2013, you stated these inspections are being and will continue to be conducted, recorded and kept at the facility.

Result:

Ohio EPA accepts this as an adequate response and requests Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat to continue to comply with all monitoring and recordkeeping requirements in accordance with the terms and conditions of PTI 06-07387.

Violation and Requested Action:

During the inspection I noticed a bucket located behind the dry cleaning machine that was filled with solvent-laden waste water. This bucket was used for the draining of pipes and was uncovered.

You stated that no lid was used on this bucket and the bucket contained solvent. PTI 06-07387 requires any bucket or barrel containing solvent or petroleum solvent-laden waste to be covered. Ohio EPA requested that Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat immediately comply with all operational restrictions in accordance with the terms and conditions of PTI 06-07387.

Response:

In the compliance plan received January 22, 2013, you stated the open container, previously used to drain water and solvent, had been removed. During our phone conversation on January 15, 2013, you stated the machine was serviced by the manufacturer. During this service, you were informed the solvent should not be drained; it is recycled through the condenser.

Result:


Ohio EPA accepts this action as an appropriate response and requests Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat continue to comply with all operational restrictions in accordance with the terms and conditions of PTI 06-07387.

Note:

In the NOV dated December 26, 2012, you were reminded PTI 06-07387 requires detailed records to be kept for solvent usage. In the compliance plan received January 22, 2013, you included the invoice of solvent purchase, including the type of solvent, the amount purchased, date of purchase and merchant.

Based on the information submitted by Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat, it appears that your facility has returned to compliance with all applicable Ohio EPA air rules.
