Dear Mr. Buckey:

On August 15, 2012, Jessica Dingman and I performed an inspection at Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat, previously known as Cambridge One Hour Cleaners Inc., located at 1775 Southgate Parkway, Guernsey County, Ohio. You were present throughout the inspection. This inspection was conducted to determine if the facility was still operating, if so, who the new owners are, and to discuss the current state and federal air pollution control rules and regulations that Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat is subject to.

The emissions unit located at Sudzee's Dry Cleaner and Laundromat includes D001, a Marvel Slimline SLPD-60 Petrol Dry Petroleum Hydrocarbon Dry Cleaning Machine. A permit-to-install (PTI 06-07387), for D001, was previously issued to Cambridge One Hour Cleaners Inc. on December 18, 2003. A permit-to-operate (PTO P0089362) was issued to Cambridge One Hour Cleaners Inc. on August 9, 2004. This permit expired on August 9, 2009. No renewal application was received by Ohio EPA for D001. Because of the expiration of the previous PTO, **Ohio EPA is requesting a new permit-to-install-and-operate (PTIO) application to be submitted by Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat within sixty (60) days of receipt of this letter.** Application forms can be accessed through <http://www.epa.state.oh.us/dapc/fops/eac/eacforms.aspx>.

Violation:

The dry cleaning machine located at Sudzee's Dry Cleaner and Laundromat is subject to a federal regulation; 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart M. A complete citation of this rule is enclosed for your convenience. As discussed during the inspection, this rule requires various records to be kept and the use of a perchloroethylene (PCE) gas analyzer to

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detect leaks, among other requirements. No records were being kept during the time of the inspection. A calendar was provided at that time to assist you in the required record keeping for the facility.

Ohio EPA requests that Sudzee's Dry Cleaner and Laundromat immediately comply with all monitoring and recordkeeping requirements in accordance with the provisions of 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart M, including the use of a PCE analyzer for PCE leak inspections.

During the inspection we discussed the need for a notification of ownership change and name change of the facility. Since the inspection, Ohio EPA received a notification of name and ownership change on August 29, 2012, and the facility information was updated accordingly.

Within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter, please provide the following information to the Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) of the Southeast District Office (SEDO) of Ohio EPA:

- a) proof that a PCE analyzer has been purchased or the plan of purchasing, as required in 40 CFR Part 63, Subpart M;
- b) a request that the previous permits of Cambridge One Hour Cleaners, Inc., for D001, be transferred to Sudzee's Dry Cleaner & Laundromat.

I have enclosed information for Ohio EPA's Office of Compliance Assistance and Pollution Prevention (OCAPP). Ralph Witte is the OCAPP contact for Ohio EPA's Southeast District Office, and his business card is enclosed. Please contact Mr. Witte if your facility needs assistance with the PTIO application.
