Dear Mr. Black:

This letter is written in regard to an industrial storm water inspection that I conducted at TFO Tech Company, LTD, on December 6, 2011, at your facility located at 221 State Street, in Jeffersonville, Ohio. The inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with your industrial storm water general permit. Your facility manufactures automotive parts. The following items were noted during the inspection, also please see attached pictures:

Please be aware that the storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3) and spill prevention control and countermeasure (SPCC) plan should be reviewed annually or after a change in management. Please have a sign-off sheet in the plans that list the date and person that reviewed the plans. If possible, please send me an electronic copy of your storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3) and your spill prevention, control and countermeasure (SPCC) plan to [greg.sanders@epa.ohio.gov](mailto:greg.sanders@epa.ohio.gov).

Please provide a diagram should the discharge locations of the storm water drains that exit your property.

There are several trash containers and roll-offs for storing waste material located outside on the grounds of your facility that did not have covers. Please insure all outside trash containers have covers.

Please use better housekeeping during the loading and unloading of the trash containers and roll-offs. There was a lot of waste material spilled on to the ground of your facility. Several areas were directly upslope of storm water drains.

There was a waste material operation leaving the building on the east side of your building. This operation was not covered nor was in contained. Waste material was being deposited on to the pavement which was directly upslope of a storm water drain and drainage ditch. Please enclose this operation.


