Dear Mr. Douglas:

This letter is written in regard to an industrial storm water inspection that I conducted at Liberty Tire Services of Ohio, on November 18, 2011, at your facility located at 3041 Jackson Pike, Columbus, Ohio. The inspection was conducted in order to determine compliance with your industrial storm water general permit. Your facility recycles used tires. The following items were noted during the inspection:

Please send me an electronic copy of your storm water pollution prevention plan (SWP3) and spill prevention control and countermeasure (SPCC) plan. Please insure that both plans are reviewed annually as per the general permit.

Please include in the plans, the most recent best management practices and controls that were added to your facility such as the containment around the storm water drains and the sliding gate at the storm water discharge pipe. Also please be sure to included maintaining the filter bags in the storm water drains and exercising the sliding gate valve.

Please be as much sediment away from the storm water drains as possible. Please see attached pictures.

It is recommended to store the waste material that will go to a landfill in dumpsters and keep a cover on the dumpsters. Please see attached pictures.
