**OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, pursuant to Sections 3745.01 and 6109.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, has issued Final Findings and Orders to ensure the Red Oaks Golf Course, Inc., public water system is operated in compliance with the State's safe drinking water laws. These Final Findings and Orders provide Red Oaks Golf Course, Inc., with a schedule for resolving its drinking water violations. This final action will be effective on November 29, 2002, and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC) pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. Antidegradation**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)-Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for the initial issuance of a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit 3IN00335 for the discharge from the proposed CEC Project 200336.0303 disposal system. The NPDES application was submitted by Lorain County II Landfill, 43502 Oberlin - Elyria Road, 44074.

The application submitted is for approval to treat a ten-year/twenty-four-hour storm event of stormwater runoff. The disposal system is proposed to be located at 43502 Oberlin - Elyria Road, Lorain, Ohio. Treated wastewaters are to be discharged into the Squires Ditch.

The discharge from this facility, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Squires Ditch. However, the chemical-specific water quality criteria developed to protect aquatic life and human health, set forth in OAC 3745-1-07, will not be exceeded. In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality.

The contents of the above stated application(s) indicated an exclusion from various portions of the antidegradation review and information submittal requirements applies as outlined by section 3745-1-05 (D) (1) of the antidegradation rule (effective as of October 1, 1996). The exclusion relates to a de minimis net increase in the discharge of a regulated pollutant.

**OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL MODIFIED HAZARDOUS WASTE PERMIT TO  
QUALITY CHEMICALS, DAYTON, OHIO**

On November 26, 2002, Ohio EPA issued a final modified Hazardous Waste Facility Installation and Operation Permit (Permit) to Quality Chemicals, Inc. for its facility at 1515 Nicholas Road, Dayton, Ohio 45418. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD004855292.

**Why is Quality Chemicals, Inc. modifying its Permit?**

Quality Chemicals, Inc. is permitted to store hazardous waste at its facility. Quality Chemicals, Inc. wishes to change the owner and operator from Quality Chemicals, Inc. to ChemFirst Electronic Materials, L.P. This final modified permit allows Quality Chemicals, Inc. to make the requested change. To issue this final modified Permit, Ohio EPA determined that the modification application is complete and meets appropriate standards.

**Can I appeal this final modified Permit?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this modified Permit, you have the right to appeal this Permit decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

**If I decide to appeal this final modified Permit, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than **December 29, 2002**. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal. You must file your appeal, according to ORC § 3745.04, with ERAC at the following address: ***Environmental Review Appeals Commission***, 236 E. Town Street, Room 300, Columbus, Ohio 43215. **OHIO EPA RECEIVES NEW HAZARDOUS WASTE CLOSURE PLAN**

On November 19, 2002, Ohio EPA received a new hazardous waste closure plan from Suburban Landfill, Inc. for its hazardous waste soil biotreatment facility located at 3415 TWP Road 447, Glenford, Ohio 43739. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHR000110221.

**Why is Suburban Landfill, Inc. Submitting this Closure Plan?**

At the request of Ohio EPA, Suburban Landfill, Inc. submitted this closure plan. This closure plan provides a description of three primary operating areas at the biotreatment unit including; a pre-treatment soil stockpile, three biotreatment piles, and a vapor treatment facility. Three tasks are described to achieve closure of the treatment facility which include: disposal of HDPE piping; soil stockpile sampling; and surface soil sampling. Also in the plan are soil sampling and analysis, closure documentation and certification; and health and safety procedures.
