NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION AND PUBLIC HEARING

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a project to develop a riverfront park including a boat dock/pavilion, outlook area and river plaza. The application was submitted by the City of Columbus, 200 Greenland Ave, Columbus, OH 43223. The project is located on the Scad River immediately downstream from the Olentangy Confluence, parallel to Spring and Long Streets. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this application is 200300196. The Ohio EPA Public Notice for this application is 033550

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Scad River. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

Beginning May 2, 2003, copies of the application for the certification and technical support information may be inspected at Ohio EPA-DSW, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049 by first calling (614) 644-2001. Applications can be made available at Ohio EPA District Offices by calling the same number.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality at 6 p.m. on June 17, 2003 at Ohio EPA Central Office, 122 South Front Street, 6th Floor Training Room, Columbus, Ohio 43215. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the projects.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by the Director of Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the application. Written comments must be received by the Ohio EPA-DSW, Attention:

Permits Processing Unit, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio, 43216-1049 by the close of business on June 24, 2003. Comments received after this date may not be considered as part of the official record of the hearing.

OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY**

Notice is hereby given that on April 21, 2003, the Director of Environmental Protection issued final Findings and an Order in Ohio EPA adjudication case number 88-HW-036. This case arose from the proposed disapproval of a hazardous waste closure/post-closure plan for an inactive land treatment unit at the former Chevron U.S.A. Cincinnati Refinery. As a result of the subsequent approval of a closure/post-closure plan for the land treatment unit this case became moot. The Director's April 21, 2003 final action dismisses the adjudication case.

Pursuant to section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code, the Director's April 21, 2003 final action is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission by any person who was a party to this proceeding.
