Notice is hereby given that on July 10, 2003, the Director of the Environmental Protection Agency issued an Isolated Wetlands Permit (Level 2) to Greystone Realty Group, 715 Wye Road, Bath, Ohio 44333. OHIO EPA RECEIVES AMENDED HAZARDOUS WASTE CLOSURE PLAN

On June 27, 2003, Ohio EPA received an amended hazardous waste closure plan from the City of Upper Arlington for its container storage unit at 4100 Roberts Road, Columbus, Ohio 43228. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD986966984.

Why is the City of Upper Arlington submitting this Amended Closure Plan?

At the request of Ohio EPA, the City of Upper Arlington submitted this amended closure plan. This amendment includes revised analytical method detection limits and revised laboratory standard operation procedures for various test methods. Components of the initial plan are also included in this submittal, such as 1) waste removal procedures including power washing and breakup of the concrete pad, and extent of contamination and soil excavation, 2) removal of containerized wastes, 3) collection and handling of samples, 4) air emissions and wastewater, 5) decontamination and 6) remediation standards for soils.

DIRECTOR'S FINAL FINDINGS & ORDERS**

Pursuant to OAC Rule 3745.02(G), notice is hereby given that on July 9, 2003, the director of Ohio EPA issued Final Findings and Orders to County Disposal (Ohio), Inc., DBA County Environmental of Wyandot, 11164 County Road 4, Carey, Ohio 43316. The orders grant County Disposal (Ohio), Inc., authorization to use a mixture of Little Scioto River dredgings and cement kiln dust (mixture) as alternative daily cover (ADC) at the County Environmental of Wyandot Landfill (Facility). County Disposal is hereby exempted from the requirement of OAC 3745-27-19(F), which prohibits the use of solid waste for use as daily cover, provided County Disposal complies with stated orders. The exemption shall terminate 180 days after the effective date of these Orders unless County Disposal receives concurrence in writing for continued use based on Ohio EPA's review of the certification report. These Orders are subject to all rules, regulations, and specified conditions.
