**OHIO EPA RECEIVES NEW HAZARDOUS WASTE CLOSURE PLAN**

On October 1, 2003, Ohio EPA received a new hazardous waste closure plan from Walker Heat Treating concerning a waste pile unit located at 10601 Briggs Road, Cleveland, Ohio 44111. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD004197307.

**Why is Walker Heat Treating submitting this Closure Plan?**

At the request of Ohio EPA, Walker Heat Treating submitted this closure plan. This closure plan is intended to support anticipated clean closure of the rear and east sides of the existing Walker Heat Treating facility. It identifies the regulatory history of the subject area, describes the hazardous waste unit to be closed, and discusses ambient air monitoring for volatile organic compounds during soil excavation, drilling and sampling activities. Sections are dedicated to an assessment and remedial standards for soil and ground water; decontamination methods; and a sampling and analysis plan which includes sampling procedures, preliminary sampling, initial confirmation sampling after source removal and soil assessment/cleanup. Finally, the closure plan provides minimum details for certification, a schedule, and closure cost estimates. .

**Why does The Lubrizol Corporation need this temporary authorization?**
