City of Cincinnati (Elmwood Place Landfill)

Notice is hereby given that on February 25, 2005, the City of Cincinnati submitted to the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("OEPA") a Notice of Entry in the Brownfields and Voluntary Action Program Memorandum of Agreement Track ("The VAP MOA Track"). The City of Cincinnati's Notice of Entry identifies the Elmwood Place Landfill at 5622 Center Hill Road as the property to undergo a voluntary action through the VAP MOA Track.

It is the intention of the City of Cincinnati to add the Elmwood Place landfill to the Center Hill Landfill and combine these two properties into a single project. The Center Hill Landfill was entered into the VAP MOA Track on July 9, 2002.

The VAP MOA Track was established by the United States Environmental Protection Agency and the Ohio EPA on July 31, 2001 to promote the cleanup and redevelopment of contaminated properties ("Brownfields") in Ohio.

The Notice of Entry, along with other documents regarding the voluntary action at the property will be made available for public inspection at the Public Library of Cincinnati and Hamilton County, at 6120 Vine Street, Village of Elmwood Place, Hamilton County, 369-4452, in accordance with the MOA.
