The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 0.22 acres of wetlands and would place 386 feet of intermittent stream into a storm sewer that extends across the property. The applicant also proposes to include 0.33 acres of new wetland in an on-site stormwater retention basin and establish a conservation easement along a stream on property it owns in Preble County. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would also impact 0.22 acres of wetlands. The intermittent stream would be redirected to a drainageway that parallels the exit ramp from I-75 north to I-70 east. This alternative would also include 0.33 acres of new wetland in its on-site stormwater retention pond and establishment of a conservation easement along a stream on property it owns in Preble County. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Upper Great Miami watershed. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

WASTE PERMIT MODIFICATION**

On April 5, 2006, Ohio EPA issued a draft Class 3 hazardous waste facility installation and operation permit (Permit) modification to Sunoco Chemicals-Haverhill Plant (Sunoco) for its facility at 1019 Haverhill-Ohio Furnace Road, Haverhill, Ohio 45636. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD005108477.

Why is Sunoco Modifying its Permit?

Sunoco is a chemical production facility that produces phenol and acetone from cumene. Wastes from the production of these chemicals are stored in three permitted tanks prior to being used as a fuel in Sunoco's boilers. Sunoco is requesting a Class 3 modification to modify Boiler UC to burn heavy and light hydrocarbons simultaneously; and start-up and operate Boiler UC in accordance with the November 2005 Boiler UC RCRA Trial Burn Plan. The draft Permit modification contains the conditions under which the facility must operate if the Permit receives final approval. To issue this draft Permit modification, Ohio EPA determined that the Permit application is complete and meets appropriate standards and that the applicant has a history of compliance with relevant environmental laws given the potential for harm to the public health and safety and the environment that could result from the irresponsible operation of the facility. When issued, the Permit modification will allow Sunoco to continue to investigate and cleanup any contamination of hazardous waste in the designated areas, or constituents that may be at the facility. Some RCRA regulations have not been authorized in the state of Ohio, therefore US EPA must issue a permit to cover those regulations. Sunoco's complete RCRA permit is comprised of both the US EPA and Ohio EPA permits.

You may request Ohio EPA to hold a public meeting for its draft permit modification.
