**Notice of Adoption of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rule 3745-21-17 of the Administrative Code.

The primary purpose of this rulemaking is to revise Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") rule 3745-21-17 as follows:

Paragraph (A) of this rule was revised to more clearly specify the certification requirements for the newly designed PFC's.

Paragraph (C) of this rule was revised in order to make style and formatting changes to conform with the legislative service commission (LSC) guidelines. In addition, an exemption was added (paragraph (C)(7)) that will allow the sale of existing stock of non-compliant portable fuel containers.

A public hearing on the proposed amendments was held on May 10, 2007 in Columbus, Ohio. After considering comments and oral testimony, the Director's order of adoption was issued on Monday, June 11, 2007. The effective date of this rule is Thursday, June 21, 2007.

TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD REPORT**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) is providing for public review and comment the Beaver Creek and Grand Lake St. Marys Watershed Total Maximum Daily Load Report (TMDL) Document. Ohio EPA developed the Document in fulfillment of Section 303(d) of the Clean Water Act, which requires the identification of impaired waterbodies for which technology based effluent limitations are not stringent enough to achieve applicable water quality standards and to develop Total Maximum Daily Loads for such waters. The Document addresses impairments in the Beaver Creek and Grand Lake St. Marys watershed that appear on the Ohio 2006 303(d) list (assessment units 05120101 020 and 05120101 030). The impaired waters are located in the Counties of Mercer and Auglaize.
