This request was submitted by Mr. Randy Bishop and Shaw Environmental, Inc., on behalf of The Former Koch Materials, LLC.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3745-300-10(D), Ohio's Voluntary Action Program (VAP) allows for the voluntary cleanup of contaminated property in Ohio without the risk of state civil liability. Under the VAP, ground water cleanup is required where contaminated ground water poses risks to the community or environment.

A USD may be requested for properties participating in the VAP when there is no current or anticipated future use of ground water by local residents for drinking, showering, bathing, or cooking. In these areas, an approved USD would lower the cost of cleanup and promote economic redevelopment while still protecting public health and safety.

Ohio EPA's director may approve the request for a USD based on a demonstration by the certified professional that the USD requirements are met and that an evaluation of existing or future uses of ground water in the area have been assessed.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a project to construct a 20.6 acre mixed office/retail/hotel development. The application was submitted by NP Limited Partnership, 8800 Lyra Drive, Suite 550, Columbus, Ohio 43240. The project is located at the northeast corner of the Worthington Road and Polaris Parkway Intersection, City of Westerville, Delaware County, Ohio. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2006-115-SCR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 083335.

As required by the Anti-Degradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 1,548 linear feet of intermittent stream and 0.316-acre of Category 1 wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would impact 1,548 linear feet of intermittent stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of unnamed tributaries and adjacent wetlands of Alum Creek. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an anti-degradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation or lowering of water quality will also be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by 3745-1-05 of the Anti-Degradation Rule, apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

On March 28, 2008, Ohio EPA issued a temporary authorization to BP Products North America, Toledo Refinery for their facility located at 401 Cedar Point Road, Oregon, Ohio 43616. The EPA Identification Number for this facility is OHD005057542.

**Why do BP Products North America Toledo Refinery need this temporary authorization?**

BP Products North America is permitted to conduct corrective action and post closure-care activities at its facility in Oregon, Ohio. On March 17, 2008, Ohio EPA received a request to allow BP-Husky Refining LLC to commence ownership of the BP Products, North America, Inc., Toledo Refinery location prior to issuance of a modified permit. The temporary authorization will allow the requested ownership change in order to prevent the disruption of ongoing waste management activities.

**Can I appeal this temporary authorization?**

Yes, if you are an officer of an agency of the state or of a political subdivision, acting in a representative capacity, or any person who would be aggrieved or adversely affected by this temporary authorization you have the right to appeal this decision to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission (ERAC).

**If I decide to appeal this final temporary authorization, how and when must I make the appeal?**

If you file an appeal, you must put it in writing no later than May 5, 2008. Your appeal must explain why you are appealing the action and the grounds you are using for your appeal.
