City of Springfield/ Buck Creek Development Property

Notice is hereby given that on December 7, 2009, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Chapter 3746 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Chapter 3745-300, issued a Covenant Not To Sue/Final Findings and Orders to the city of Springfield for the property identified as the Buck Creek Development Property (the "Property").

The city of Springfield conducted a voluntary action of the 4.308-acre Property located at 225 to 250 Cedar Street and 220 to 236 ½ Cliff Street, Springfield, Clark County, Ohio. A no further action letter was submitted on March 31, 2009 to the Voluntary Action Program of the Ohio EPA Division of Emergency and Remedial Response on behalf of the city of Springfield by Craig Kasper, a Certified Professional (CP103), as defined in ORC 3746.01(E) and OAC 3745-300-01(A)(8).

You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA requests that a copy of the appeal be served upon the Ohio Attorney General's Office, Environmental Enforcement Section.
