PROPOSED SETTLEMENT OF CERCLA CLAIM
URBANA, OHIO**

Notice is hereby given by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA") of the following proposed resolution of a claim under Section 107 of the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act ("CERCLA"), 42 U.S.C. § 9607, and Ohio Revised Code Chapters 3734 and 3746, and the rules adopted thereunder. Ohio EPA has reached an agreement with Siemens Energy and Automation, Inc. ("Siemens") and Gould Electronics Inc. ("Gould") (collectively Siemens and Gould are the "Proposed Settlers") to resolve their liability to the State of Ohio for costs of response associated with the facility located at 145 Dellinger Road, Urbana, Champaign County, Ohio ("Dellinger Road Facility").

Under the proposed settlement, which is embodied in an Operation and Maintenance Agreement and Settlement, proposed to be attached to and incorporated in Director's Final Findings and Orders granting a Covenant Not to Sue under the Voluntary Action Program ("VAP"), the Proposed Settlers have agreed to pay Ohio EPA \$100,000 to resolve their liability to the State for the actual direct and indirect non-VAP costs of response, as that term is defined at 42 U.S.C. § 9601(25), incurred and to be incurred by Ohio EPA with respect to the releases of hazardous substances identified and addressed in the No Further Action ("NFA") Letter submitted by the Proposed Settlers to Ohio EPA with respect to the Dellinger Road Facility.
