On May 28, 2010, Ohio EPA approved a closure plan for North East Chemical Corporation for its former container and tank storage units located at 3301 Monroe Avenue, Cleveland, Ohio. The EPA I.D. number for this facility is OHD980681571.

Pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code rule 3745-66-11 & 12, the facility's closure plan received on October 29, 2008 and revised on May 29, 2009 and March 1, 2010, was approved with modifications as outlined in the Director's May 28, 2010 correspondence. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to replace two existing 18-inch diameter bare steel natural gas distribution pipeline segments with one new 24-inch diameter coated steel pipeline segment. The application was submitted by The East Ohio Gas Company, 320 Springside Drive Suite 320, Akron, OH 44333. The project is located within the municipalities of the City of Independence, Cuyahoga Heights, and Brooklyn Heights, between E. 49th Street/Canal Road and Valley Belt Road. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is Application No. 2009-01817. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 103618.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in temporary impacts to 71.6 linear feet of two streams and 1.23 acres of five wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in temporary impacts to 62.5 linear feet of one stream and 0.26 acre of three wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of wetlands in the Cuyahoga River watershed. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Persons wishing to 1) be on Ohio EPA's interested parties mailing list for this project, 2) request a public hearing, or 3) submit written comments for Ohio EPA's consideration in reviewing the application should do so in writing to Ohio EPA-DSW, Attention: Permits Processing Unit, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049 within thirty days of the date of this public notice.

OHIO EPA ISSUES FINAL FINDINGS AND ORDERS TO
AIR PORT TAXI SERVICE**

On May 28, 2010, Ohio EPA issued final Findings and Orders to Air Port Taxi Service, Inc. for its facility located at 1579 Joyce Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43219. This facility disposed of hazardous waste on-site without a permit, but provided post closure care and monitoring plan documentations to Ohio EPA. The EPA I.D. number for this facility is OHD081315863.

Air Port Taxi Service, Inc. must achieve compliance with Chapter 3734 of the ORC and the regulations promulgated thereunder according to the detailed compliance schedule. Air Port Taxi Service, Inc. is now exempt from applying for a Facility installation and operation permit. This final action was not preceded by a proposed action and is appealable to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission.

**PUBLIC NOTICE
PROPOSED CONSENT ORDER**

The Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) has entered into a proposed Consent Order with William Walker Sr., et al., d.b.a. Hillview Mobile Home Park (Defendants), to resolve all claims alleged in the complaint filed by the State of Ohio, Stark County Court of Common Pleas case number 08-CV-05100. The proposed Consent Order requires the Defendants to comply with all applicable provisions of Ohio's Water Pollution Control Law, R.C. Chapters 6111 and 6109 and the rules and regulations promulgated thereunder, and the terms and conditions of any permit, license, or plan approval that may be issued to the Defendants. The proposed Consent Order also requires that the Defendants immediately refrain from making changes to Hillview's Wastewater Treatment Works ("WWTW") until an approvable Permit to Install application for such a change has been submitted and approved by the Director. Defendants shall bring or maintain the WWTW in full compliance with the terms and conditions of Exhibit A until Hillview's WWTW is tied into the Village of Brewster's ("Village") Publicly Owned Treatment Works. Further, Defendants shall also immediately hire and/or retain an operator of record who holds a valid Class I Wastewater Works Operator Certificate until such time as Hillview's WWTW is connected to the Village's Publicly Owned Treatment Works. By September 1, 2010, Defendants shall submit a fully signed legally binding Agreement and Declaration of Covenants for Extension of Village Sewer Services. Defendants also shall connect their WWTW into the Village's Publicly Owned Treatment Works by no later than 60 days after the Village notifies them in writing that it is available and abandon their WWTW by no later than 30 days thereafter. Finally, the proposed Consent Order requires payment of a thirty thousand dollar (\$30,000.00) civil penalty.

The final approval and entry of the proposed Consent Order will not occur until after the thirty (30) day public comment period has expired. The thirty day period commences **on June 14, 2010**. Both the State of Ohio and William Walker, Sr., et al., d.b.a. Hillview Mobile Home Park reserve the right to withdraw or alter the proposed Consent Order based on comments received during the public comment period.
