Notice is hereby given that on June 23, 2010, the Director of the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency ("Ohio EPA"), pursuant to Ohio Revised Code ("ORC") Chapter 3746 and Ohio Administrative Code ("OAC") Chapter 3745-300, issued a Covenant Not To Sue/Final Findings and Orders to Deluxe Business Operations, Inc. and East State Street Development Company, LLC (the "Volunteers") for property known as the Former McBee Systems property (the "Property").

The "Volunteers" conducted a voluntary action of the approximately 23.492-acre Property, which is located at 1055 East State Street, Athens, Athens County, Ohio. A no further action letter for the Property was submitted on February 24, 2009 to the Voluntary Action Program of the Ohio EPA Division of Emergency and Remedial Response by Matthew D. Knecht, a Certified Professional as defined in ORC 3746.01(F) and OAC 3745-300-01(A).

This action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to ORC 3745.04. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit it is demonstrated that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Ohio EPA Finalizes Decision Document for
Franklin Steel Company, Blacklick, Ohio

On June 28, 2010, Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) finalized a Decision Document identifying the selected alternative to remediate contamination at the Franklin Steel Company (a.k.a. Columbus Steel Drum) site located at 1385 Blatt Boulevard in Blacklick, Ohio (Franklin County).

The site was constructed in 1971 on approximately 38 acres; two 10-acre drum storage areas and an 18-acre drum processing and storage area. The process operation involves the reconditioning and recycling of used 55-gallon steel drums. The site has numerous localized areas with elevated contaminant levels in the soils of the process operation area and the sediments of the adjacent stream. These contaminants include metals, semi-volatile organics and volatile organics. The selected alternative includes: soil and sediment excavation and removal, monitored ground water natural attenuation, an environmental covenant limiting future site activity to industrial/commercial and prohibiting the use of ground water for potable water, institutional controls, and a long-term operation and maintenance plan.

On February 25, 2010, Ohio EPA issued a Preferred Plan that outlined Ohio EPA's preferred alternative to remediate contamination at the Site. A public meeting was held April 14, 2010, during which public comments on the Preferred Plan were accepted. In addition, written comments on the Preferred Plan were accepted through April 23, 2010. The comments received by the Agency during the comment period are addressed in the Responsiveness Summary attached to the Decision Document.

The effective date of this final action is June 28, 2010. You are hereby notified that this action of the Director is final and may be appealed to the Environmental Review Appeals Commission pursuant to Section 3745.04 of the Ohio Revised Code. The appeal must be in writing and set forth the action complained of and the grounds upon which the appeal is based. The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the

Why is Environmental Processing Services submitting this Closure Plan?

At the request of Ohio EPA, Environmental Processing Services, Inc. submitted this closure plan. This plan describes the proposed air sparge and soil vapor extraction system to reduce constituent of concern concentration in groundwater to within the risk-based remedial action objectives.
