The appeal must be filed with the Commission within thirty (30) days after notice of the Director's action. The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00, made payable to "Ohio Treasurer Kevin Boyce," which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a 47.5 foot long seawall project and 10 foot wide by 53 foot long steel crib pier along the Lake Erie shoreline. The application was submitted by Michael and Mary Beth Wallace and is located at 31980 Lake Road, in Avon Lake Ohio. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice # for this project is 2010-00576. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 103654.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in 244 cubic yards (CY) of fill placement and occupy a 1,430 square foot (SF) area on the Lake Erie bottom, below the ordinary high water mark (OHWM). The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in 217 CY of fill placement and occupy a 1,340 SF area on the Lake Erie bottom, below the OHWM. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 certification for a project to construct surface facilities associated with underground mining activities. The application was submitted by Gatling Ohio, LLC. The project is located approximately two miles north of Racine, in Sutton Township, Meigs County. The Huntington District of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Number for this project is LRH-2009-863-OHR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 103693.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 616 feet of intermittent stream. The proposed minimal degradation if approved, would impact 457 feet of intermittent stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Bowman's Run watershed. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.

NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to replace 150 linear feet of a damaged natural gas pipeline. The application was submitted by East Ohio Gas Company. The project is located along the Tuscarawas River on the north side of Navarre, Ohio. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers has issued a Nationwide Permit #12 for this project. The Corps' Project Number for this project is LRH-2010-01040-TUS-adjacent wetland. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113723.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would temporarily impact 0.073 acres of a Category 3 wetland. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would temporarily impact 0.041 acres of a Category 3 wetland. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state. However, the pipeline would not be replaced or repaired with this alternative.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Category 3 wetland. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality on Thursday, March 24, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at the Navarre Village Hall, 27 W. Canal Street, Navarre, Ohio 44662. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the application.

Ohio EPA will continue to accept written comments on the application through the close of business on Thursday, March 31, 2011. Comments received after this date may not be considered as part of the official record of the hearing.
