Notice of Adoption of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted new rules 3745-31-34 and 3745-77-11 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

The intent of these new rules is to adopt rules that are consistent with, and no more stringent than, the Federal Greenhouse Gas Tailoring Rule (75 FR 31514, June 3, 2010).

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC is required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally adopts them. On January 5, 2011, these rules went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes was conducted on February 11, 2011 in Columbus, Ohio. There were comments received which prompted OEPA to amend the rules for clarification. On the whole, however, the comments were very positive and supportive of the rulemaking. The Director's order of adoption was issued on March 21, 2011. The effective date of these rules is March 31, 2011.

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rules 3745-18-01, 3745-18-54, and 3745-18-82 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). These rules are related to the control of emissions of sulfur dioxide in Lucas and Stark counties.

The primary purpose of this rulemaking is to satisfy the requirements of Section 119.032 of the Ohio Revised Code (five-year review). Specific changes to the rules include removal of emission limits for facilities that have been shut down, and various minor changes to correct typos and update the rule language in this chapter to meet legislative service commission (LSC) style and formatting guidelines.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the division formally adopts them. On June 25, 2010, these rules went out for a 30 day review by interested parties. Several comments were received during the draft comment phase, primarily identifying additional shut down facilities which were added to the rule changes. Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on these rule changes was conducted on January 7, 2011 in Columbus, Ohio. Two comments were also received during the proposed rule comment period resulting in the removal of three rules from this rulemaking for further changes. These 3 rules will be adopted in a separate rulemaking.

The Director's order of adoption was issued on March 24, 2011. The effective date of these rules is Sunday, April 3, 2011. NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF 401 APPLICATION**

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to replace the Auburn Road bridge where Auburn Road intersects with Sherman Road. The application was submitted by the Geauga County Engineer. The project is located at the intersection of Sherman and Auburn Roads, in Munson Township. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2010-00523. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 103709.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would be for the replacement of the Auburn Road bridge and realignment of Sherman Road. The impacts would be to 214 linear feet of the Chagrin River and 0.273 acres of wetland, of which 0.248 acres would impacts to Category 3 wetlands. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would be for the replacement of the Auburn Road bridge with a box culvert of the same dimensions and orientation of the existing structure. The impacts would be to 100 linear feet of the Chagrin River and no impacts to wetlands. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Chagrin River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted. Starting March 15, 2011, copies of the application and technical support information may be inspected at Ohio EPA-DSW, Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio, by first calling (614) 644-2001. Copies of the application and technical support information can be made available upon request at Ohio EPA District Offices by calling the same number.

Ohio EPA will hold a public information session and public hearing relative to issues of lower water quality on Thursday, May 5, 2011 at 6:30 p.m. at the Munson Township Hall Community Room, 12210 Auburn Road, Chardon, Ohio 44024. The public hearing will end when all interested parties have had an opportunity to provide testimony related to the project.

All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and give written or oral comments on the proposed project. The purpose of the hearing is to obtain additional information that will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to any further action on the application.

Ohio EPA will continue to accept written comments on the application through the close of business on May 12, 2011. Comments received after this date may not be considered as part of the official record of the hearing.
