The appeal must be accompanied by a filing fee of \$70.00 which the Commission, in its discretion, may reduce if by affidavit you demonstrate that payment of the full amount of the fee would cause extreme hardship. Notice of the filing of the appeal shall be filed with the Director within three (3) days of filing with the Commission. Notice is hereby given that on May 25, 2011, a **draft** Solid Waste Permit to Install (PTI) No. 06-08446 was issued to Cardinal Operating Company, P.O. Box B, Brilliant, Ohio 43913. The permit, if issued as a final permit, authorizes partial lateral and vertical expansion and partial lateral and vertical retraction of the approved limits of waste placement at the Cardinal FAR1 Residual Waste Landfill (Facility), an existing residual solid waste landfill located approximately one mile north of the Cardinal Plant which is located on Co. Rd. 7E, Brilliant, Ohio 43913 in Jefferson County. With the partial retraction of the permitted limits of waste placement within the northern portion of Cell 3, six existing groundwater monitoring wells will be retained. The expansion will increase the total disposal capacity to 18,943,000 cubic yards. The total acreage within the limits of waste placement will increase from 126.97 acres to 129.45 acres. The anticipated daily waste receipt for the Facility is 4,050 tons.

A Public Information Session/Public Hearing will be held on Thursday, June 30, 2011, at 6:00 p.m. at the Wells Township Office Building, Meeting Room, 409 Prospect, Brilliant, Ohio 43913. Written comments relevant to the draft solid Waste PTI will be accepted until July 7, 2011 for the director's consideration.
