Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA)-Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft general permit authorization to discharge wastewater from temporary discharges.

Temporary discharges may be associated with some type of facility or site cleanup, or one-time emergency discharge due to unusual or short-term circumstances, or discharges from a pilot project or test facility. The type of pollutants found in temporary discharges may be quite variable due to the differences in projects. Flow rates can be different depending on the size of the project. The concentration of the discharges must be *de minimus*, defined as less than 65 mg/l for total suspended solids, less than 10 mg/l for oil and grease and less than ten percent of the waste load allocation for all other applicable pollutants. In addition, temporary discharges are defined as facilities or projects that discharge for a time period not to exceed 60 days.

This permit would be the renewal of a general permit, and will be subject to the requirements of Ohio's anti-degradation rule (Ohio Administrative Code 3745-1-05). The general permit is proposed for a duration of five years.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has issued a draft general National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit to renew coverage to only those water treatment plants that discharge wastewater from plain purification, lime-soda softening and iron-manganese removal processes in the State of Ohio.

Applicants under this permit include water treatment facilities that discharge similar type wastewater while producing potable water. Water treatment plants that discharge wastewater from ion-exchange and reverse osmosis processes (this includes wastewater from plants using combined treatment of ion-exchange and iron and manganese removal process) are not covered by this general permit. The fact sheet explains why they are not covered. Key parameters monitored in this draft permit are: total suspended solids, chlorine, alkaline pH values and suspended metals.

This general permit will cover only existing permitted facilities. New water treatment plant dischargers will need an individual permit and must go through the antidegradation procedure. Notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Division of Air Pollution Control (DAPC) is proposing an amended rule in Chapter 3745-17 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC) to the Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review (JCARR). This rule is related to the control of particulate emissions from industrial processes. The change in the rule package includes the modification of the following existing OAC rule: 3745-17-11.

Pursuant to Section 121.39 of the Ohio Revised Code, DAPC was required to consult with interested parties affected by the rules before the Division formally adopts them. On July 27, 2011 this rule went out for a 30-day review by interested parties. No comments regarding this action were received by Ohio EPA. Therefore, no response summary has been prepared.

Pursuant to Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code, a public hearing on this rule change will be conducted on Tuesday, November 15, 2011 at 10:30 AM, at Ohio EPA, Lazarus Government Center, 50 W. Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

Pursuant to Part D of Title I of the Clean Air Act, Ohio EPA is required to establish a state implementation plan (SIP) for the attainment and maintenance of the National Ambient Air Quality Standards. The above-mentioned rule is a part of Ohio's SIP and the proposed amendment will be submitted to USEPA as a modification of the SIP. The above-mentioned hearing shall be considered the public hearing for the SIP submittal. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented at the hearing and give written or oral comments on these rule changes. All oral comments presented at the hearing, and all written statements submitted at the hearing or by the close of business on November 15, 2011, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rule. The application was submitted by Mr. Lee J. Krendl. The project is located at 7 Bath Street, Put-In-Bay. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 1999-00772. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113812.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would discharge 56.5 cubic yards of stone fill below the ordinary high water mark of Lake Erie for the 12 foot by 46 foot dock. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would discharge 44.5 cubic yards of stone fill below the ordinary high water mark of Lake Erie for the 12 foot by 40 foot dock. Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie.
