Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project address after-the-fact stream fill associated with and underground limestone mining facility. The application was submitted by Arch Materials, LLC. The project is located at 4438 State Route 276, Batavia, Clermont County. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2006-2261-ELM. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113728.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in the relocation of 1,919 linear feet of an unnamed tributary to Backbone Creek and would sever the connection to Backbone Creek. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would also result in the relocation of 1,919 linear feet of unnamed tributary to Backbone Creek, but would maintain the connection to Backbone Creek. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would be the restoration of the stream to pre-impact conditions and would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Backbone Creek. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality.
