Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to relocate the Col. James M. Schoonmaker to a new berthing area at the Skyline Marina and Park Area. The application was submitted by the City of Toledo. The project is located at 1552 Front Street, Toledo, Ohio. The Buffalo District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is 2011-00644. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 113820.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would install 658 linear feet of sheet piling and dredge approximately 4.872 acres of river bottom resulting in 242 cubic yards of fill being placed below the ordinary high water mark of the Maumee River and dredging of 76,000 cubic yards. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would install 1,438 linear feet of sheet piling and dredge approximately 4.1 acres of river bottom resulting in 242 cubic yards of fill being placed below the ordinary high water mark of the Maumee River and dredging of 66,000 cubic yards of material. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of the Maumee River. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.

The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 2,030 feet of jurisdictional perennial stream, 3,064 feet of jurisdictional intermittent stream, 2,034 feet of jurisdictional ephemeral stream and 2,131 feet of non-jurisdictional ephemeral stream (9,259 feet total). The proposed minimal degradation if approved, would impact 2,030 feet of jurisdictional perennial stream, 1,040 feet of jurisdictional intermittent stream, 1,312 feet of jurisdictional ephemeral stream and 1,561 feet of non-jurisdictional ephemeral stream (5,943 feet total). The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on streams or wetlands.

The discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Crooked Creek watershed. The review of the application will be conducted, and a decision whether to grant or deny the application will be made, in accordance with Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC). In accordance with OAC 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of the water quality. Other alternatives resulting in lesser or no degradation, or lowering of water quality, will be considered by Ohio EPA during the review process.

No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by Paragraph 3745-1-05 (D) of the Antidegradation Rule (effective as of May 1, 1998), apply or may be granted by the Director of Ohio EPA.
