Notice of Adoption of Rules**

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rule 3745-17-11 of the Administrative Code.

This rule was previously finalized and became effective on February 1, 2008. The 2008 version of the rule was conditionally approved by U.S. EPA into the Ohio state implementation plan (SIP) on December 27, 2010. In order to obtain full approval Ohio EPA agreed to incorporate an additional change which was documented in U.S. EPA's final Federal Register dated October 26, 2010. This rule change addresses concerns raised by U.S. EPA regarding paragraph (A)(1)(I) of Ohio's 2008 rule.

Specifically, the following text is added to paragraph (A)(1)(I) of this rule; "... any such exemption approved by the Director must be approved by the U.S. environmental protection agency as a revision of the state implementation plan." This wording is similar to what Ohio EPA has used before in OAC rule 3745-21-09(B)(2) for Director's discretion items in the VOC rules and is agreeable to U.S. EPA. With this proposed amendment U.S. EPA will grant full approval, regarding this rule, to Ohio's revised SIP. Federal Register Volume 75, No. 206, FR 65569-70 provides the full explanation of the needed change.

A public hearing on this rule was held on November 15, 2011 in Columbus, Ohio. After considering comments and oral testimony, the Director's order of adoption was issued on December 13, 2011. The effective date of this rule is Friday, December 23, 2011.

NPDES Big Darby Creek Watershed Construction Storm Water General Permit
Renewal**

On the basis of staff review and application of standards and regulations, on December 17, 2011, the Director of the Environmental Protection Agency will issue a draft alternative general permit renewal for storm water discharges associated with construction activity located within the Big Darby Creek watershed. The draft permit will be issued as a final action unless the Director revises the draft after consideration of the record of a public hearing or written comments, or upon disapproval by the Administrator of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. Any person may submit comments on the draft permit and administrative record.

The NPDES Alternative General Permit for Storm Water Discharges Associated with Construction Activity located within the Big Darby Creek watershed (Permit No. OHCD00002) is the second generation of this general permit. This permit would cover the entire Big Darby Creek watershed and would authorize storm water discharges from construction activity disturbing one or more acres. Also, the permit would authorize some discharges that are not entirely storm water (such as trench dewatering), as well as storm water discharges from on-site concrete and asphalt batch plants. This permit identifies who can apply to be covered, how an entity obtains coverage and how a permittee terminates coverage. The permit contains requirements for permittees to prepare and implement storm water pollution prevention plans (SWP3s). The SWP3 is the permittee's plan to minimize contamination of storm water that will be discharged to surface waters from the site.
