Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Section 3752 of the Ohio Revised Code and in accordance with Chapter 119 of the Ohio Revised Code, proposes to adopt amendments to, or submit for review pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 119.032 without amendment, the following 9 rules of the Ohio Administrative Code (known as the CRO rules):

Purpose of rule-making. The primary purpose of this proposed rule-making is to review these rules pursuant to Ohio Revised Code (ORC) section 119.032, which requires Ohio EPA to review certain rules every five years, and to make corrections as necessary.

A public hearing pursuant to ORC sections 119.02 through 119.04 will be conducted on Tuesday, February 7, 2012 at 10:30 a.m. in conference center room B at the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency, Lazarus Government Center, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio. All interested parties are entitled to attend or be represented and give their written or verbal comments on this proposed rule-making. A presiding officer will be present until 11:00 a.m. or until all interested parties have been heard if more time is necessary.

If you plan to attend the hearing, please be aware that all visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (e.g., a valid driver's license); it is a requirement for building admittance. For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete security procedures.

To give notice of intent to provide verbal comments at the public hearing, please contact Kit Arthur; her contact information is at the end of this notice. To facilitate scheduling of verbal presentations, people who intend to give testimony at the hearing should ensure that Ohio EPA receives notice of such intent by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, February 6, 2012. Those who provide Ohio EPA with prior notice will be heard before those who register at the hearing.

Comment due date. In order to assure that written communications are considered as part of the official record of this hearing, written communications must be received by Ohio EPA by 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, February 7, 2012. Written communications may be filed with the presiding officer during the hearing, or provided via U.S. mail or email to Kit Arthur. Your emailed comments on these rules are welcome, but *must* include the sender's name and phone number in order to be verified and considered.
