Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for installation of a new crib pier along the Lake Erie shoreline. The application was submitted by Amy Murphy, 3890 Waterford Court, Orange Village, Ohio 44122. The project is located at 323 East Point Boulevard, Put-in-Bay, South Bass Island, Ottawa County. The Corps of Engineers Project # is 2012-00087. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123865.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would result in 326 cubic yards (CY) (1,800 square feet) of fill placement on the Lake Erie bottom, below the ordinary high water mark (OHWM). The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in 290 CY (1,800 square feet) of fill placement on the Lake Erie bottom, below the OHWM. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Lake Erie. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
