Notice of Adoption of Rules
“Ambient Air Quality Standards”

Notice is hereby given that the Director of Environmental Protection, under the authority of Ohio Revised Code Section 3704.03 has adopted amended rules 3745-25-01 and 3745-25-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC).

The amendments make Ohio’s ambient air quality standards (AAQS) in OAC Rule 3745-25-02 (Ambient Air Quality and Emergency Episode Standards) current and equivalent in relation to recent changes to the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for particulate matter, sulfur dioxide, ozone, and lead.

A public hearing on this rule was held on May 7, 2012 in Columbus, Ohio. No comments were received on these rules.

The Director’s order of adoption was issued on June 4, 2012. **The effective date of these rules is June 14, 2012.**

The pretreatment and indirect discharge programs regulate the discharge of industrial wastewater from industrial facilities into publicly owned treatment works (POTWs). These facilities, known as industrial users, discharge process wastewater often contaminated by a variety of toxic or otherwise harmful substances. Because POTWs are usually not specifically designed to treat these substances, pretreatment programs are needed to eliminate potentially serious problems that occur when these substances are discharged into public sewer systems. The pretreatment program is mandated under the federal Clean Water Act and U.S. EPA has delegated the program to Ohio for implementation. These two chapters of the Ohio Administrative Code provide the administrative requirements for the development and implementation of pretreatment programs.

Section 119.032 of the Revised Code requires Ohio EPA to review its rules every five years to determine whether they should be changed. The Agency has reviewed the pretreatment and indirect discharge programs rules and has identified needed changes. The following four rules in these chapters, OAC 3745-3-02, 3745-3-05, 3745-36-01 and 3745-36-06, are being filed concurrently with no changes.

The public comment period will run until **5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2012**. A public hearing on these proposed rule amendments will be held to consider public comments in accordance with Section 119.03 of the Ohio Revised Code. This hearing will be held in **Conference Room A at the Ohio EPA Central Office, 50 West Town Street, Suite 700, Columbus, Ohio at 10:30 a.m. on July 11, 2012**. All visitors to Ohio EPA must register at the Security desk in the lobby upon arrival. Please bring photo identification (such as a valid driver's license). For security reasons, visitors are required to wear their badge at all times while in the building. Please arrive early to complete these procedures.

To facilitate the scheduling of oral presentations, persons intending to give testimony at the hearing should notify the Ohio EPA Public Interest Center, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus, Ohio 43216-1049, (614) 644-2160. Prior registration will ensure that registrants are heard ahead of those individuals who register at the hearing. Oral testimony may be limited to five minutes, depending on the number of persons testifying. All interested persons are entitled to attend or be represented and to present oral and/or written comments concerning the proposed rules.

Written testimony should be sent to the attention of Rule Coordinator at the Ohio EPA Division of Surface Water, P.O. Box 1049, Columbus Ohio 43216-1049. Written comments may also be submitted to the Hearing Officer at the public hearing. Written testimony will receive the same consideration as oral testimony. All testimony received at the hearing or by **5:00 p.m. on July 11, 2012**, will be considered by Ohio EPA prior to final action on this rulemaking. Written comments submitted after this date may be considered as time and circumstances permit.

Public notice is hereby given that the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) Division of Surface Water (DSW) has received an application for, and has begun to consider whether to issue or deny, a Clean Water Act Section 401 water quality certification for a project to construct an enhanced high rate treatment facility which would provide preliminary treatment and disinfection of flows discharging from CSO 522. The application was submitted by the Metropolitan Sewer District of Greater Cincinnati. The project is located at the intersection of Werk Road and Westbourne Drive in Green Township, Hamilton County. The Huntington District Corps of Engineers Public Notice Number for this project is LRH-2010-895-OHR. The Ohio EPA ID Number for this project is 123877.

As required by the Antidegradation Rule, rule 3745-1-05 of the Ohio Administrative Code (OAC), three alternatives have been submitted for the project. The applicant's proposed preferred alternative, if approved, would impact 1,066 linear feet of intermittent stream (Schaible Creek) and 392 linear feet of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed minimal degradation alternative, if approved, would result in the filling of 700 linear feet of intermittent stream (Schaible Creek) and 392 linear feet of ephemeral stream. The applicant's proposed non-degradation alternative, if approved, would have no direct impacts on waters of the state.

Discharges from the activity, if approved, would result in degradation to, or lowering of, the water quality of Schaible Creek and unnamed tributaries to Schaible Creek. Ohio EPA will review the application, and decide whether to grant or deny the application, in accordance with OAC Chapters 3745-1 and 3745-32. In accordance with OAC rule 3745-1-05, an antidegradation review of the application will be conducted before deciding whether to allow a lowering of water quality. All three proposed alternatives will be considered during the review process. No exclusions or waivers, as outlined by OAC rule 3745-1-05, apply or may be granted.
